

About AirDisk

AirDisk is the newest way to store and transfer files between computers at home, at work, and at school. Take your files wherever you need to go and be able to review them on the go.

System Requirements

- Wireless Network Connection
- Internet Explorer 7.0+, Mozilla Firefox 2.0+, or Safari 3.2+
- Windows Explorer or other FTP client for FTP access.

Loading Files

1. Before opening AirDisk, ensure you are connected to the internet.
2. After AirDisk has loaded, check the connection by tapping the colored status indicator in the bottom left corner.
3. If you do not have an FTP client, enter the HTTP address into your Internet browser. From this window, you can upload files, add folders and download the files that you have stored on your iPod or iPhone.
4. If you have an FTP client or are using a Windows computer, simply enter the FTP address into your FTP client or Explorer's address bar. To add files, simply drag and drop into the window.
